

## FASCINATING FIND

### FACE AT SCOTTISH SITE



At the back of the famous Scottish Gympie Gold Mines site along Brisbane road at Monkland is this aboriginal face which has been added to a concrete wall.

The Gympie Times in 1982 reported that the artist was Peter Dechnik, who worked for the council for 28 years. Peter modelled the face during his lunch hour in the late 70s.

He also added a face to the stone-pitched wall on the corner of Cootharaba and Rifle Range roads, and another on a wall somewhere near Albert Park.
