This 1923 Austin 20 was once the Governor of Queensland's tourer, but it went downhill from there until the museum acquired it as rusting wreck a few years ago.

After many hours of volunteer's work, and several thousand dollars, it has been re-created as a replica of a 1920s Gympie Ambulance vehicle, and it is now on display in the ambulance shed adjacent to our new fire station.
