

FASCINATING FIND

JUICE EXTRACTOR



This juice extractor dates back to the turn of the previous century and was made by the Enterprise Manufacturing Co. Philadelphia, USA, who made a large range of domestic and agricultural products.

Constructed of cast iron with a perforated metal strainer basket, the press is operated by turning the handle, which via the gearing and piston, presses the fruit, squeezing the juice out, and leaving the bulk of the pulp in the basket. The four feet can be screwed to the table to secure it.

It was donated by Cullinanes, and is on display in the tank at the gold mining museum.
