Travellers along Brisbane Road may have noticed the Lower Wonga school building undergoing restoration. The school closed in 1968, and the building was moved to Gympie and used for years by the Scout Cubs at Queen's Park.

The recent relocation and restoration of the building is funded by the museum with the assistance of a grant from Jupiters Community Benefit Fund. It will become a communications technology museum, with the lower level utilised as our machinery workshop above moderate flood levels.
