MODEL BULLOCK WAGON



Until about a hundred years ago bullock or horse drawn wagons were the mainstay of heavy road transport for moving heavy loads like machinery or sawlogs.

This model of a bullock wagon was made and donated by Ainger Labuschewski , is about 600mm long, and is part of the transport display in the House at the museum.

Volunteers at the museum are involved in the lengthy process of restoring a very old bullock wagon which was donated many years ago. Unfortunately we have no details about its history.
