

## FASCINATING FIND

### DUMP TRUCK



This 6 ton tipper was made in 1950 by Aveling Barford in Grantham, England.

It is powered by a Doreman 4 cylinder diesel engine. The front tyres are 8.25 - 20, and the rear 14.00 - 24.

The cabin with drivers seat and pedals rotates around the two steering wheels for operation in reverse.

Before being donated to the museum it was last used by Mr Shultz at his gold mine at Byee near Murgon.

Today's mining trucks carry payloads of 400 tons.
