

## FASCINATING FINDS

### MILNER SAFE

This large fire-proof safe was built by Milner in 1891 in England.

It was used by the Mary Street businesses of Shamblers, Abdys Bros, and finally Campbells Hardware, who donated the safe to the museum in 1987.

During the 1960s robbers opened the safe using an oxy-acetylene torch to cut through the half inch thick steel plate door.
