BRADY JINKER



This 1938 DS35 petrol powered International truck was purchased new by Len Brady, and fitted with a turntable and timber jinker trailer. It was used to cart timber from the Goomeri, Cinnabar and Kimbombi areas, as well as being used as family transport, and even used to move a house.

The truck retired in the 60s, and the Brady family donated the truck to the museum in 1983.

Unfortunately the 1999 flood damaged the timber work and the brake system, so in the last few years volunteers at the museum have restored the entire truck and jinker to be fully operational.

It can be viewed in the machinery shed.
