CHILDS BOOT



This tiny little leather boot is less than 100mm long, (4 inches), and must have been made for a very small child. Not much is known about it, just that it was found on the Gympie goldfield in 1870. It appears to be constructed just like a full size lace up work boot.

The boot was donated to the Museum by Bert Spring Jnr, and it is on display with the collection of boot-making equipment in the House.
