### CLYDE'S HUT



*This small shed, which is now known as Clyde's Hut, was the waiting room at the Sexton railway siding. Sexton is on the rail line from Theebine to Kilkivan. The line is now closed.*

*The siding was used during the late 1890s gold mining at the nearby Devil's Mountain.*
